- Printed copy of online application
- Official transcripts of previous college/university work. (Note: International applicants must send one set to the School and one set to Graduate Admissions)
- Letter of intent detailing study goals
- Three letters of recommendation (no forms required), signed by the recommender across the back envelope flap. These may arrive separately
- Graduate Record Examination (GRE) taken within five years
- Resume of professional work experience
- International applicants only:** Evidence of proficiency in English - minimum TOEFL score of 580P or 237C; English courses will be required for scores below these minimums.

International applicants and those who are applying by mail must send the following two to four items (as applicable) to:
